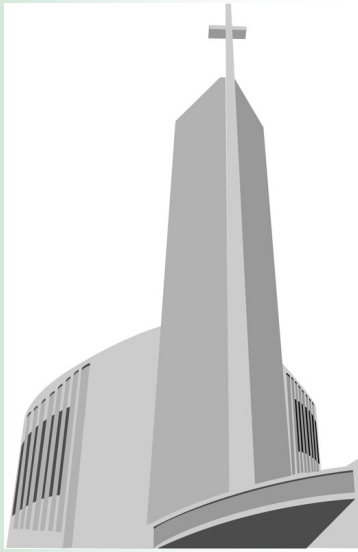

◆ **BLESSING BAGS FOR KC'S HOMELESS: HELP OUR YOUTH HELP OTHERS**

During our Youth Lock-In (July 28-29), our young people will assemble blessing bags. Blessing Bags are gallon-size Zip-loc bags to be kept in your car, so when you encounter a person who is experiencing homelessness, you can offer the bag to them. Pope Francis challenges us to never pass up a homeless person without offering them something! We are asking parishioners to donate the following items for the blessing bags: individually wrapped soft granola/cereal/breakfast bars, single-package nuts and trail mix, peanut butter-and-crackers, new wash cloths, wet-wipe packets, new white tube socks, foot powder, antibacterial salve, bandages, combs, travel-size toothpaste and lotion, lip balm, toothbrushes, toilet paper, gallon-size and snack-size Zip-loc bags. The bags will also include a note of encouragement (written by our youth) and a card with shelter information. There will be a donation bin in the narthex July 2, 9, and 16.
