Rockhurst Jesuits' Mass - The KC Jesuit Community is live streaming their daily Jesuit Community masses from the Community's chapel. **Weekday masses, Monday thru Friday, will begin streaming promptly each evening at 5:15pm. Sunday morning masses will be streamed every Sunday at 10:30am.** They intend to offer Mass in this form until such time as our local dioceses lift the necessary suspension of public masses in order to reduce the risk of spreading of the Covid-19 virus.

- Access to the live stream mass may be reached simply by going onto YouTube and typing in the search bar: "KC Jesuit Community" and pressing "Return". The computer screen will then open to a series of YouTube offerings, at the top of which will be found the following icon, , representing the "KC Jesuit Community" YouTube Channel.
- Click on the  and it will open to the Channel. The screen should appear when it is time for the mass to start, and the live streaming will begin automatically at the time for the mass.

Fr. Steve's homilies – Go to our sfx-kc.org website and scroll down the main page to access Fr. Steve's Sunday and Solemnities homilies.

Triduum – All Triduum Masses (April 9-13) are suspended. Priests will celebrate them in a restricted way as dictated by Bishop Johnston. Watch this update or check the SFX website for an opportunity to celebrate online with the Jesuits.

Easter – We will NOT be packing the church on Easter. Bishop Johnston has suspended all public Masses through April 24.

Health Ministry – The Health Ministry is hosting another tele-conference call this Saturday, March 28 at 4:00 PM. Currently, the limit is 12 participants, but this can be expanded if there is interest. Here's how to get in:

1. Right at 4:00, dial **816-994-7990**
2. Enter the participant code at the prompt: **560346#**
3. You will be asked to "please say your name, followed by the # key."
4. The participant may be told s/he is the first person on the call and will know to wait for the moderator to open the call.
