**Jesuits' Masses** - The KC Jesuit Community is live streaming their daily Jesuit Community Masses. Weekday Masses, Monday thru Friday, begin each evening at 5:15 PM. Sunday morning Masses will be streamed at 10:30 AM.

The Jesuits will also stream **Triduum liturgies: Good Friday – 3:00 PM Easter Vigil - 8:00 PM Easter Sunday – 10:30 AM**

- Access to the live stream Mass may be reached simply by going onto YouTube and typing in the search bar: "KC Jesuit Community" and pressing "Return". The computer screen will then open to a series of YouTube offerings, at the top of which will be found the following icon, , representing the "KC Jesuit Community" YouTube Channel. Click on the  and it will open to the Channel. The screen should appear when it is time for the Mass to start, and the live streaming will begin automatically at the time for the Mass.

**Other Jesuit Resources** – The current pandemic is changing many things.
